Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our school provides healthy meals each day. For the 2021-22 School year, the USDA has approved FREE lunches for all students until June of 2022. The normal cost of a MOLMS lunch cost is \$2.75 and MOLES lunch cost is \$2.50.

This year more than any other year it is critical for you to complete the enclosed Application for Educational Benefits following the instructions. The state and federal funding we receive through the public school district is allocated using a formula that is heavily influenced by the number of free and reduced lunch students enrolled in our school. These funds pay for our school nurse, our school counselor, our title one support and textbooks/equipment. A new application must be submitted each year. At public schools, your application also helps the school qualify for education funds and discounts.

Return your completed Application for Educational Benefits to *either Mary of Lourdes School offices* and **receive one volunteer credit.**

Who can get free school meals? Children in households participating in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), and foster, homeless, migrant and runaway children can get free school meals without reporting household income. Or children can get free school meals if their household income is within the maximum income shown for their household size on the instructions.

I get WIC or Medical Assistance. Can my children get free school meals? Children in households participating in WIC or Medical Assistance may be eligible for free school meals. Please fill out an application.

Who should I include as household members? Include yourself and all other people living in the household, related or not (such as grandparents, other relatives, or friends).

May I apply if someone in my household is not a U.S. citizen? Yes. You or your children do not have to be U.S. citizens for your children to qualify for free or reduced-price school meals.

What if my income is not always the same? List the amount that you normally get. If you normally get overtime, include it, but not if you get overtime only occasionally.

Will the information I give be checked? Yes, and we may also ask you to send written proof.

How will the information be kept? Information you provide on the form, and your child's approval for school meal benefits, will be protected as private data. For more information see the back page of the Application for Educational Benefits.

If I don't qualify now, may I apply later? Yes. Please complete an application at any time if your income goes down, your household size goes up, or you start receiving SNAP, MFIP or FDPIR benefits.

Please provide the information requested about children's racial identity and ethnicity, which helps to make sure we are fully serving our community. This information is not required for approval of school meal benefits.
