

MARY OF LOURDES OFFERS VARIOUS **SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT**

There are three sources of scholarship funding or assistance available that MOL offers to assist families with tuition.

The 1st source is called the “FAIR Scholarship”, which is received by completing an application form that is mailed to an outside agency for review. That agency makes a recommendation on how much scholarship funding to award per student. The applications are available in early February and are due (online or hard copy) by April 15th, directly to the FAIR company.

For those families who apply and do not qualify for a FAIR scholarship, they may contact either building principal to apply for a “Support a Student” scholarship (the 2nd scholarship source offered at MOLS through the generosity of parishioners who contribute to this fund!). This application is due by the end of August. It may be dropped off at either school office.

- **NOTE: You must apply for FAIR in order to qualify to apply for Support a Student. You do not need to be approved for FAIR, you just need to apply prior to requesting Support a Student.**

Another way families can receive tuition assistance is by purchasing local and retail gift certificates through the MOL Scrip Program. Families receive tuition credit based on the amount of purchases made throughout the year.

Please feel free to request FAIR & ‘Support a Student’ applications at either school office.
